INSTALLATION PREP GUIDE:

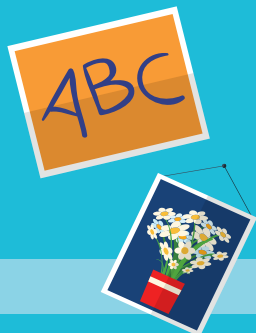
Here's a quick checklist to help you prep before we arrive.

CLEAR THE CANVAS

SAY GOODBYE TO
OLD POSTERS
AND SIGNS

Any posters, signs, decorations, and tape currently up in the areas that will be wrapped need to come down.

Time to clear the stage for the new star of the show!



MOVE OUT THE BIG STUFF

If there are any bulletin boards, TVs, or whiteboards on the walls that we're wrapping, they need to be removed.

Think of it as a mini-makeover before the big reveal!



FIX UP ANY FLAWS

Check for damage. Holes, chips, or rough spots should be patched up, sanded smooth, and primed.

Remember, our wraps aren't magic, if there are any flaws, they will show through.



FRESH PAINT?

If you've recently painted, give it a two-week breather before we start.

Fresh paint needs time to cure, and we want everything to stick just right.



OUTDOORS AREAS? TIME FOR A QUICK CLEAN

For any outdoor wraps, give those surfaces a good rinse with water and wipe them down.

Dust and debris can affect the finish, and we want everything looking clean and crisp.



WE'LL TAKE CARE OF THE INSTALL

Reminder that our installers aren't responsible for removing items or prepping surfaces.

The better the prep, the better the end result!
